This Webinar focuses on the apply Intelligence Analysis on Libya in order to answer specific question on the current and future situation to support Decision Makers.

Intelligence Analysis, based on OSINT, is proposed over the realistic current case study focused on Libya and considering its relative complexity. Obviously, a major step is related to the capability to identify and select data sources and in using different tools and methods. The STRATEGOS Class and Guests are invited to investigate this Scenario and to be ready to answer to questions as well as to discriminate between unclear situation, opens issues, criticalities interactively during the Webinar. The Libya is the result of a mix over different regions, cultures and even tribes since Roman Time and involve many different aspects and a long story that are important to understand the context. Therefore this complexity deals with the problem to be able to frame the current Scenario and address specific questions of Decision Makers by providing Intelligence Service based on modern Analysis, OSINT & Strategic Engineering methods.

The problem includes investigations over a wide spectrum of points of views including **Geo-Political Strategies**, **Strategic Natural Resources**, **Industrial Initiatives** as well as by considering the nature of the **Different Players** and their expectations and capabilities. From this point of view it is overstressed the importance during the analysis to be able to properly **identify** and **evaluate** the **different info & data sources** as well as to check **correlations** & **inconstancies**, **process data**, **discriminate manipulation & fake news**, **evaluate different players goals and constraints**, **discriminate plots from idiocy**, **extract interests**, quantify **risks** & **opportunities**.

The **STRATEGOS** Class had the task, to get a **picture of the Libya** and to able to plat this **Game** with **the Chairs** that play as **Decision Makers**.
