UNIGE Educational Guidelines devoted to mitigate the Epidemic Risks and adopted by STRATEGOS

Pending any new ministerial measures subsequent to the Prime Minister's Decree of 25 February 2020, as well as any new provisions of the Liguria Region, the University of Genoa has developed an extraordinary action plan for teaching, to guarantee full regularity to the continuation of the 2019-2020 academic year, even in the event that new measures to suspend teaching activities happen. Genoa University will provide supplementary notes if necessary on the basis of these provisions and will update the situation. In case the suspension of all training activities will be prolonged the, following directions will be updated and it should be considered as first guidelines to mitigate the Epidemic Risks and to safeguard the interests of the students, balancing them with the regular functioning of the teaching activities

Lessons & Exams

The following remain suspended: all face-to-face educational activities, including internships, including external ones, including those of students of the three-year, master's and single-cycle degrees of the health professions; frontal teaching activities for doctoral students; frontal didactic activities for the students; educational activities for PhD Thesis. Lessons, oral exams will be carried out *Remotely*, via Video Conferences, Recorded Lectures, On-Line Exercises, Web Conferences, Webinars, Web Portals or other systems. The exams should be conducted in compliance with the publicity of the exam sessions activities and taking care the student conduct it directly. Several activities could be carried out on the AulaWeb online platform, according to proper methods. Recommendations will be communicated by individual Structures and by individual Teachers to their Students. The written exams should be moved forward and re-scheduled according to modalities to be defined by the single Structures & Teachers to their Students.

Students meetings with Teachers

The live meeting among teachers and students should take place only by individual appointment, in order to avoid crowding.

Student Secretariats

The offices guarantee ordinary functionality, but students are invited to use remote services as a priority.

Study Rooms, Libraries & University Museums

The study rooms of all the University and Departments offices will remain closed, including the spaces inside the Libraries, as long as it will be required

The opening services of libraries and university museums to the public are expected to be suspended as long as it will be required

PhD Students and Post Graduate Grants

Their Research activities continue regularly, taking care to avoid situations of overcrowding of the spaces used.

University Department, School, Technical-Scientific Courses And Study Courses

They still operate, possibly evaluating the use of web solution to carrying out different activities such as Meeting, Events, conferences, seminars, workshops, etc.

All cultural, scientific and educational events or initiatives are allowed, which take place in a public place or open to the public, taking care where possible to avoid overcrowding.

Competitions

All public competitions will be resumed.

Missions

University staff missions to places included in the territories clearly affected by the infection are suspended. More generally, staff are invited to go on a mission only if strictly necessary and the managers of the Structures are urged to pay particular attention in issuing the relative authorizations.
